



In-Network vs. Out-of-Network- High Option

Example*:

The <u>average fee</u> for a porcelain crown is **\$1200** The average allowance for a crown is **\$700**

	In-network	Out-of-Network	
United Concordia covers	50% of the allowance	35% Out-of-Network allowance	
The dentist charges	\$700 (the in-network allowance)	\$1,200 (no discount)	
Which means	You - 50% of the allowance or \$350 United Concordia - \$350	You – 65% + difference between our allowance and the average fee (\$1,200 - \$700 = \$500) Total: \$955 United Concordia – \$245

Choosing an in-network dentist helps lower out-of-pocket costs and eliminates the need to fill out claim forms.
