How it Works

The Treatment Cost Estimator is tailored to each member's individual health plan benefits. When members search and compare costs for services using the Treatment Cost Estimator, they see the most accurate estimate for out-of-pocket cost sharing for that specific service. The Treatment Cost Estimator automatically applies the deductible, copayment, coinsurance and out-of-pocket maximum.
